DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

- Via Hwy 99 - From the north or south in Gridley on Hwy. 99, turn east on Hazel at the traffic light. Drive one block and you will enter the fairgrounds.
- Via Hwy 70 - From north or south on Hwy 70 turn west at East Gridley Rd traffic light continue west and turn right on Fairview Dr then right on Hazel and enter the fairgrounds..

Additional Exhibitor Information:

Dogs must be on a leash at all times while on farm site unless confined in a crate, kennel or vehicle. The leash shall be four to six feet in length. Dogs must wear a secure, well fitting, flat collar during the test evaluation. Handlers can use verbal cues, hand signals, and praise provided it is not excessive in the opinion of the judge.
